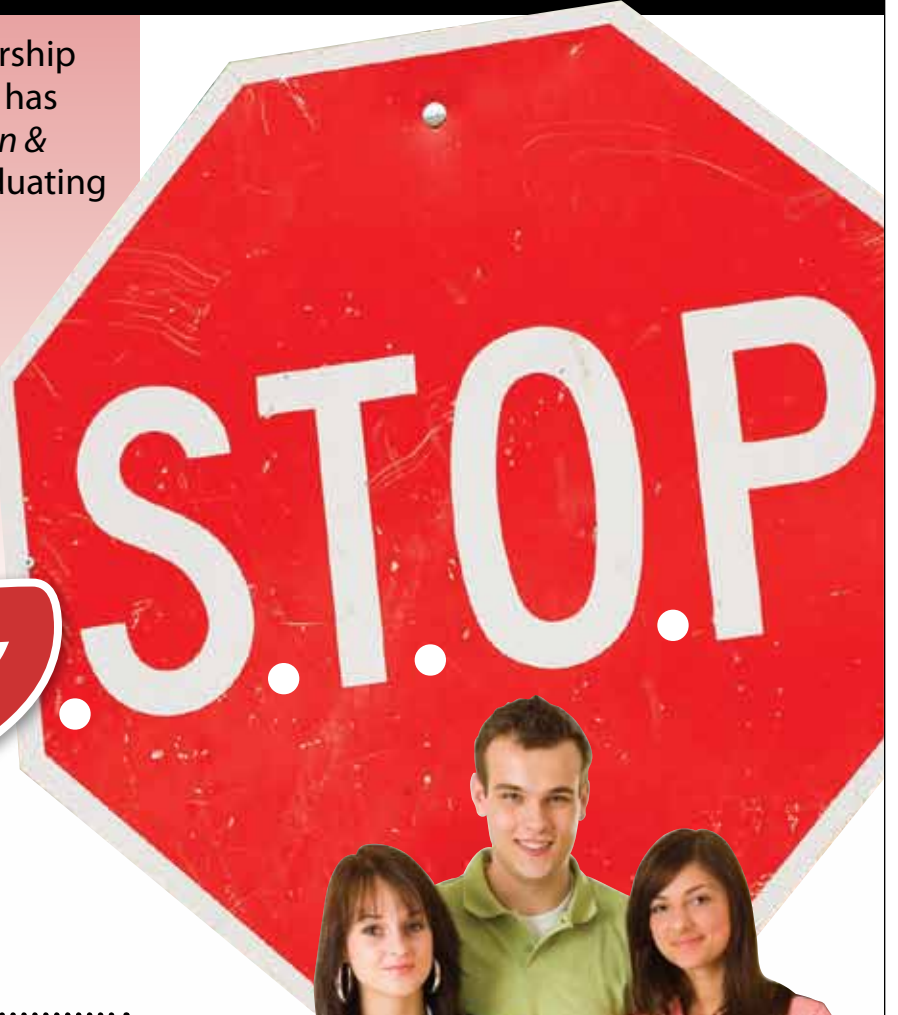

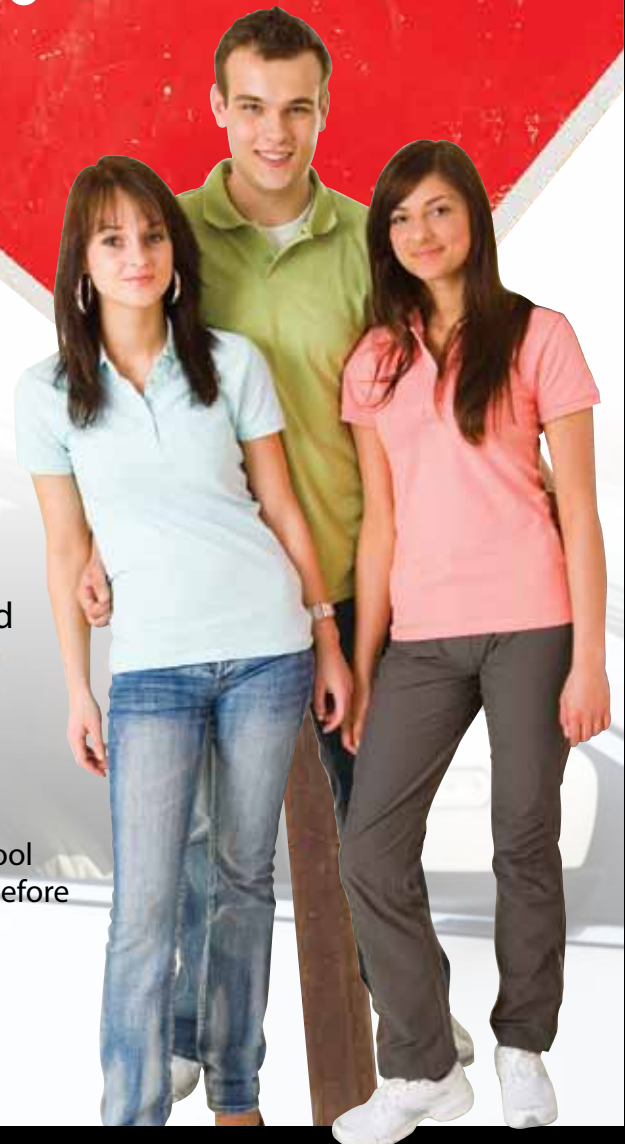

Only Northeast High school seniors who live in Oakland Park and have a valid driver license are eligible to apply for the S.S.T.O.P program award. In order to be considered, students must submit their driver license records from August 2010 to April 2011 to School Resource Deputy **Doug Davis** in the administrative offices on or before April 19, 2011.
