Use this letter as the basis for a serious discussion with your son or daughter. Very often there is time to get back on track if your son or daughter is not showing progress toward fulfilling graduation requirements. If you have questions or concerns, call your student's counselor immediately!

Basic Graduation Requirements for the Class of 2010

*Depending upon your selected diploma option, earn 24 or 18 high school credits in SPECIFIC SUBJECT AREAS

*Pass BOTH the Reading and Math portions of the Florida Comprehensive Assessment Test (FCAT)

*Earn a 2.0 Minimum Grade Point Average for Graduation

Algebra 1 or equivalent required as one of the three required math credits

Depending on your diploma option, 0 or 40 hours of Community Service

Credits Earned: Student's Cumulative unweighted GPA

Student has earned service learning hours to date.

Has student met the Reading Test Requirement?
Has student met the Math Test Requirement?

Does student have 4 English credits?
Does student have 3 Math credits?
Has student completed the Algebra Requirement?
Does student have 3 Science credits?
Has student completed the Life Management requirement?
Has student completed the Personal Fitness requirement?
Has student completed the PE requirement?
Has student completed the Computer requirement?
Has student completed the Performing/Fine Arts
