COMMISSIONER ANNE SALLEE NAMED NEXT VICE MAYOR of OAKLAND PARK

OAKLAND PARK, Fla...(November 17, 2010) – The Oakland Park City Commission has voted to appoint Commissioner Anne E. Sallee to serve as the City's next Vice Mayor. She is scheduled to be sworn in as Vice Mayor on March 16, 2011 and as Mayor on March 21, 2012.

Commissioner Anne Sallee settled in Oakland Park, after living in the Caribbean, Berlin, Germany and nine different states. She has been involved in many aspects of Oakland Park since relocating in 2003. After graduating from the City's first Local Government Academy in 2005, she reactivated her South Royal Palm Acres neighborhood organization, joined the board of Oakland Park Main Street, Oakland Park Kiwanis and served on the Code Enforcement Board. She is also an active member of the board of Broward Meals on Wheels. As a member of the Oakland Park Historical Society, she published the first pictorial history of Oakland Park, just in time to celebrate the City's 80th birthday, July 1st, 2009.
