SUBJECT: Coral Lakes Dredging Project

The City of Oakland Park is pleased to announce that the construction contract for the Dredging of the Coral Lakes System was awarded to Gator Dredging on March 2nd, 2011.

The project consists of **dredging of the choke points** along the Coral Lakes Canal from the South side of Oakland Park Boulevard to Floranada Road. Dredging will be conducted using hand held hydraulic dredging. Currently, the Contractor is conducting Pre-dredge survey around the areas to be dredged. Construction activities will take place Monday through Friday from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. each day with a projected end date of July 7th, 2011.

Residents and businesses may experience temporary driveway and parking closures in certain areas. We will communicate approximately 48 Hrs in advance of driveway closure if any and provide alternative access / parking by posting Maintenance of Traffic (MOT) signs on site. Staging area plans, updated maps and diagrams and others information pertinent to the project will also be continuously posted on our City's website and OPTV Ch. 78.
